CONDITIONS OF APPLICATION

1. Passes are non-transferable and must be worn correctly at all times. Security lockdown of Queensland Tennis Centre commences on Thursday 31st December 2009. Passes must be worn from this day or access to the venue will be denied.
2. Accreditation is a privilege not a right. Tennis Australia reserves the right to refuse accreditation. Completion of this form does not guarantee approval of application.
3. Brisbane International accreditation policies displayed at the point of registration apply to all approved applicants. Breach of any policy may result in the confiscation of the pass and the withdrawal of accreditation privileges.
4. Approved applicants agree to attend any induction prior to the allocation of pass id required by Tennis Australia.
5. Access is restricted in accordance with the pass.
6. Approved applicants will be subject to Brisbane International Ticket Conditions of Sale and Entry (located at all venue entry points) and Terms and Conditions of Accredited Entry (see below).
7. By signing this form, the company agrees to indemnify Tennis Australia for any injury, loss or damage suffered by any person at the venue as a result of the act or omission (both direct and indirect) of an applicant Accredited by Tennis Australia.
8. Passes remain the property of Tennis Australia and must be returned upon request.
9. Approved applicants are required to personally collect and sign for their passes, and by doing so agree to abide by Brisbane International Terms and Conditions of Accredited Entry.
10. Should Tennis Australia deem it necessary, it reserves the right to undertake any background checks, including police checks, to which applicants hereby consent.

Privacy Statement

Tennis Australia is bound by the Privacy Act 1988 and the National Privacy Principles ("NPP"). The NPP's set out the way organisations collect, store, use and distribute information. Tennis Australia requires the information listed in this form to provide you with accreditation for Brisbane International 2009 and for related purposes which can reasonably be expected, including but not limited to the administration and delivery of the Brisbane International.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ACCREDITATION

1. In consideration of being granted the right to enter Queensland Tennis Centre, including designated restricted access areas, all accredited entrants are required to abide by the Brisbane International Ticket Conditions of Sale and Entry, and the following Accreditation terms and obligations:
2. Accreditation is a privilege not a right which Tennis Australia may withdraw at anytime.
3. Passes are non-transferable and must be worn correctly at all times.
4. Access is restricted in accordance with Tennis Australia approved activities only, including any future directions which may be given from time to time.
5. Any breach of Brisbane International Accreditation policies may result in the confiscation of accreditation passes and the withdrawal of all accreditation privileges.
6. Queensland Tennis Centre Emergency Procedures must be adhered to at all times.
7. Accredited applicants agree to the Brisbane International Ticket Conditions of Sale and Entry displayed at all venue entry points, including agreeing not to hold Tennis Australia responsible for any personal injury, loss or damage however caused, including any negligence (but not gross negligence), breach of duty, default and / or omission on the part of Tennis Australia (except in the case of employees injured in the course of performing their duties to whom this exclusion does not apply).
8. Tennis Australia officials can lawfully direct accredited entrants during the Event (including bump in and bump out).
9. All accredited entrants must also abide by the following accreditation policies:
 - (a) Not to take unauthorised photos, video stills or video footage within restricted areas of the venue and according to official Brisbane International Ticket Conditions of Sale and Entry;
 - (b) Not to request autographs;
 - (c) Not to leave dependent children unsupervised; and
 - (d) Not to gamble or bet on tennis, whether directly or indirectly, or supply otherwise private information to another aiding the other party's gambling [Note – only applies to Competitors, Coaches, Competitor Guests, Agents and Manufacturers, Tennis Australia Staff and Brisbane International Tournament Staff; or those with access classifications including change rooms.
10. Any breach of Brisbane International accreditation policies and/or the above terms and conditions may result in serious penalties, including but not limited to confiscation of accreditation pass and withdrawal of all accreditation privileges for this Brisbane International or future Brisbane Internationals as well as loss of appointment or employment, where applicable.
