

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. To enter, you must complete the survey conducted by Tennis Australia and Nielsen Sports, provide your email address and answer the game of skill question " **Please tell us briefly which upcoming Queensland event (<http://www.queensland.com/events>) you're most excited about and why?**

There will be one winner, with entries judged based on the humour, originality and creativity of the entrant's submission as determined by the judges from Nielsen Sports at their absolute discretion.
